UPDATED INFORMATION on Sept. 2, 2020– Please read!

Dear Church Family,

Greetings from the Pastoral staff and the Deacon Board. As you know we have not been able to meet “in person” for the past two Sundays. Thank you for your prayers for those who were sick and protection for those who were in “close contact”. I am glad to report to you that we are able to once again meet “in person” beginning this coming Sunday, September 6th. As we continue to navigate these uncertain times, we want you to know that we are taking seriously your “safety” and “well-being”, while offering ministry opportunities to help you grow and connect with Jesus and people. Please note times and info below:

Beginning Sept. 6

- #1 Worship Gatherings: Sundays @ 8 & 11 AM/ In person or online
- #2 Sunday Life Groups: Sundays @ 9:30 AM/ In person
- #3 Kids Ministry: Sundays @ 9:30 AM/ In person (Kids Church Rooms in Family Life Center, Parents are required to check in/out each child, children need to bring a facemask)
- #4 Student Ministry: Sundays @ 9:30 AM/ In person (In the Family Life Center: room next to pop machine, students need to bring a facemask)
- #5 All other ministries are off campus or online until further notice.

What is the church doing to create a “safe” environment?

- #1 Asking Everyone to practice “social distancing”, everywhere on church property.
- #2 Asking Everyone to wear masks when “social distancing” is not possible.
- #3 Asking Everyone to sit with those who they have been in “close contact” (i.e. Households that live together, sit together) and social distance from those who they have not.
- #4 In the worship center we have marked off pews so that everyone can easily social distance; we have created 10’ of space for singing (behind and in front) and 6’ to each side.
- #5 Life Group rooms have been arranged for “social distancing” as well as allowing for #3 to be practiced.
- #6 All high contact areas are sanitized and disinfected regularly during and after all times above.
- #7 If you are sick or showing symptoms of being sick, please stay home and enjoy the services online.

****Close Contact:** Defined as being with a person for more than 15 mins without social distancing on a regular basis.
